

NextBuses is the great new way to get bus times on your internet enabled mobile smartphone.

To use NextBuses, just follow these three simple steps:



Open the internet on your phone and enter the web address: nextbuses.mobi

Or, you can text the word 'traveline' to 84268 and we'll send you a link to the NextBuses website.

Once you're on the NextBuses 2 homepage, either a postcode, a street, town or the bus stop code you'll find on each timetable display at your stop.

- Click on your stop from the results list. Don't forget to choose the bus stop on the correct side of the road! You can use the links shown on the screen to look at more places on the map. If you've entered a location and can't find your bus stop, try searching by postcode.
- With some practice, you'll quickly arrive at a list of buses from your stop. If you click on a service number, you'll see a longer list of bus times for just that route.

You can bookmark the page so, in future, your bus times will be just one click away!

What is the GONOW YOUTHZONE card?

The card will act as your Youthzone membership card and your travel card. It gives you discounted bus fares to and from the Blackburn Youth Zone.

Who has developed the card?

Blackburn Youthzone, Blackburn with Darwen Borough Council, NoW Card and the bus operators of the borough.

Can I get one?

Yes, if you're aged between 16 and 19 and are a member of Blackburn Youth Zone. It will be valid until your 20th birthday.

What if I'm under 16?

You will also get a card which will act as your membership card and travel card. This card entitles you to discounted under 16 bus fares.

How much do I save?

This is dependent on when you use it and on which bus you are travelling on. Please see the terms and conditions or look at www.blackburnyz.org or www.blackburn.gov.uk/gonowyouthzone

Where and when can I use it?

You can use your GONOW YOUTHZONE card on most buses in the Blackburn with Darwen area, with discounts varying according to when you use it.

How does it work?

Simply place your card on the ticket machine smartcard reader, let the driver know where you are travelling to and pay your single or return fare.

How much is the card? The card is included within your Youth Zone membership fee.

How long will the card last?

Until the day before your 20th birthday for the 16 - 19 card. For under 16's the card will be valid for three years from the date of issue and renewed with an updated photograph. The under 16's card expires on 31st August following your 16th Birthday.

How do I apply? By completing the application form which you can get at the Youth Zone or online.

What do I need to take with me? Don't forget to take a passport photo with you as well as proof of age.

Acceptable proof of age can be one of the following:

- NHS medical card
- Driving licence
- Passport
- Birth certificate

Youth Zone staff will check your application and identification

What if the card is lost or stolen?

Ring 01254 585003. A charge is payable for the replacement of any lost or stolen cards.

What if my card doesn't work?

You may have to pay the full fare for your journey. You should return your card to the Youth Zone as soon as possible and a replacement will be issued to you.

Where and When You Can Use The GoNOW YouthZone Card

For the under 16 card: This can be used to claim the standard under 16 discounted fare on all the borough's scheduled bus services.

For the 16 – 19 card:

LANCASHIRE UNITED / SPOT ON

1. 40% discount on adult single and return fares

2. Can be used on services terminating / originating

from Blackburn and on Blackburn Outer Circle

3. Schooldays: can be used after 2pm on journeys into Blackburn Town Centre and from 5pm on journeys from Blackburn Town Centre

4. Non-schooldays and weekends: can be used all day on services terminating / originating from Blackburn and on Blackburn Outer Circle

DARWEN COACH SERVICES

1. 25% discount on adult single and return fares

2. Can be used on all Darwen Coach Services routes at any time

ROSSENDALEBUS

1. 10% discount on regular single and return fares at any time on most Rossendalebus routes

2. Discounted Rossendale Rover tickets

3. At least a 33% discount on regular adult single and return fares in the Blackburn area when travelling on schooldays after 2pm into Blackburn Town Centre and from 5pm on journeys from Blackburn Town Centre, and all day at weekends and school holidays.

HOLMESWOOD COACHES LTD (ON BEHALF OF LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL)

 33% discount on adult single and return fares.
Can be used at any time on Services 15 (Mellor), 25 (Clitheroe) or 35 (Longridge) for journeys terminating in or originating from Blackburn.

Normal adult fares apply on Stagecoach services

M&M COACHES

Normal adult fares apply on M&M services
