## Appendix 1 - Detailed breakdown of changes to Greater Manchester fares \& products

## C1 - Greater Manchester (TfGM) area fares

- Some Anytime Day Single (SDS) will increase by up to 20p, no changes have been made to Anytime Day Return (SDR) or Weekly Season tickets (7DS)
- All Off-Peak Day Return (CDR) fares will increase by up to a maximum of 50 p - taking the maximum CDR fare to $£ 5.40$ within Greater Manchester
- TfGM accompanied Child tickets increases to 60p Single and £1.20 Return
- Metrolink - fares for travel wholly on Metrolink - no change
- No change to TfGM concessionary arrangements
- No change to TfGM Wayfarer tickets or Buscard Extra prices or thresholds
- Revised prices of GM Traincard and GM Countycard are shown below:
